

## **Couples Therapy**

Approach: From the Alpine Club follow the regular trail to Echo Canyon, pass the sign and drop into the creek at the bottom of the grotto. Continue up the trail for approximately 200 meters and look for a trail leading up lookers right. Follow this trail through 3 switchbacks until you arrive at the base of the cliff.

A: Dirty Laundry 12b currently the left most line at the crag. Climb out of a scoop into the corner feature. Continue up through pockets until the route steepens and the climbing gets harder. Pull the roof and navigate your way to the anchors.

- B: Shopping Spree 11b Start to the right of Dirty Laundry in the corner feature. Awesome!
- C: The Doghouse 12a Starts just right of Shopping Spree. Technical and engaging all the way up. Some really tricky sections with good rests between.
- D: Flaws Are Features 12b. I found this line to be the most technical of the bunch. Be prepared for some amazing, thought provoking climbing, especially up high.
- E: Cuddle Time 11b Finishing off Ian and Chris Perry's vision, this is one of the nicest 11a's around.
- Climb up through two large pods into a corner feature that continues to the top of the wall.
- F: Trophy Wife 12a Start just right of Cuddle time, through an array of amazing water features to a interesting crux through a bulge. Continue up beautiful face climbing to the top of the wall
- G: The Happy Accident 12b. Can you say underclings? Powerful at the bottom, delicate through the middle and exciting to the finish.
- H: Blind Date 12b Climb the obvious corner: Enjoy!
- G: Pulling the Goalie 12b Climb up to a blunt roof feature, and pull with difficulty straight up. Once established over the roof continue up through beautiful and engaging climbing and don't let your guard down until you are standing on the chert blocks below the anchor.
